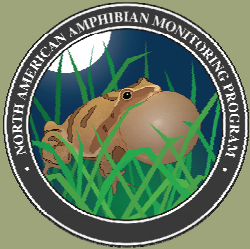
## CASP Workshop: Learn your frog calls!
