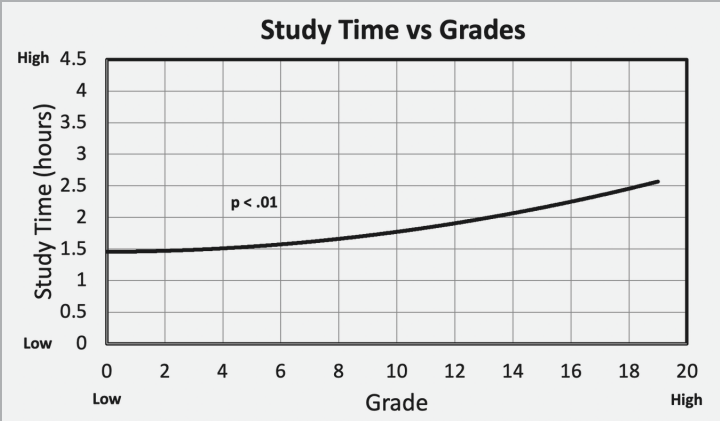
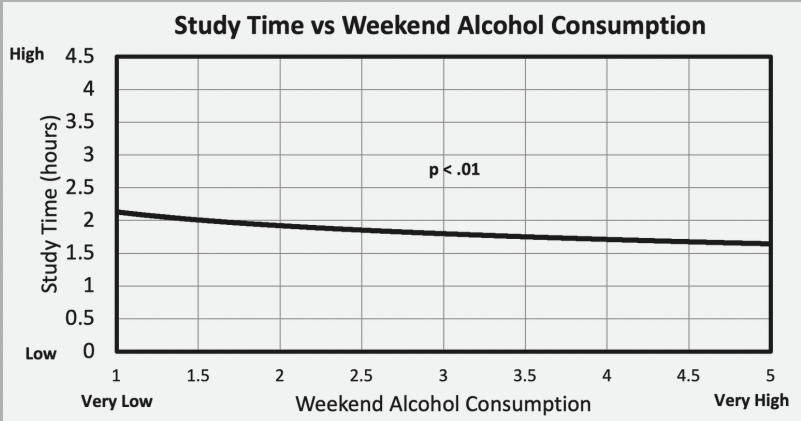
~80%

Who is going out?

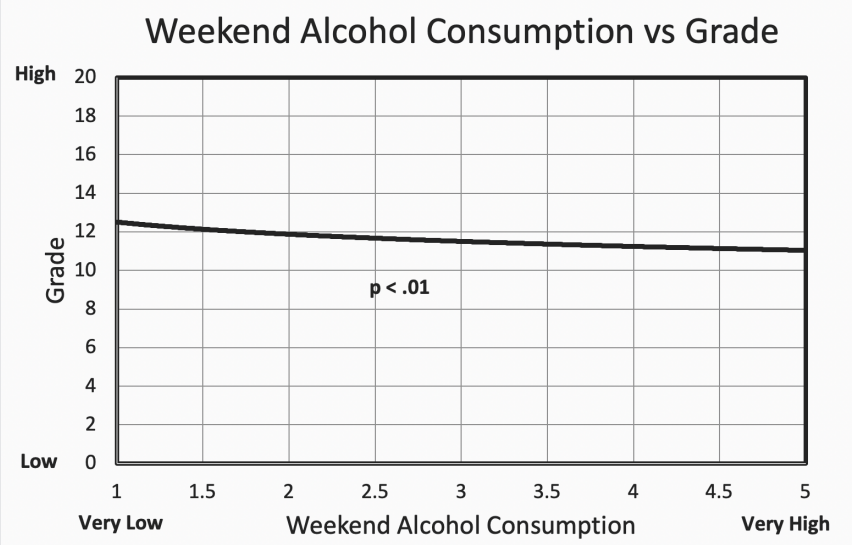


More Drinking → Less Studying → Worse Grades



- The more someone drinks, the less they study
- The less someone studies, the worse they perform academically

Alcohol Consumption Negatively Affects Grades



- Greater alcohol consumption is negatively correlated with academic performance
